

GET ON THE SUBJECT & STAY ON THE TRACK (John 3, 4)

- **1.** What is your religious background? Do you go to a church, temple, or mosque?
 - Respond with something complimentary.
- **2.** Give your salvation testimony (when you heard the good news of Christ's sinless life, death, and resurrection; how you made the decision to trust Christ; how Christ has changed your life since):

- **4.** May I take a moment and show you how you can know for sure?

JOHN 3:16 "FOR GOD SO LOVED THE WORLD..."

1. The Creator has always loved us & had a special plan for us.

<u>Genesis 1:1, 26-28</u> "In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth....And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion...over all the earth...So God created man in his own image...male and female created he them. And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth...and have dominion...over every living thing..."

2. But our sin separates us from God, the Giver and Sustainer of life. (To rebel against God is to choose death.)

Romans 5:12 "Wherefore, as by one man [Adam] sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:"

Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;"

Romans 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death..."

Revelation 20:14 "And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death."

Revelation 21:8 "But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death."

"...THAT HE GAVE HIS ONLY BEGOTTEN SON..."

- **3.** God loves us so much—He sent His Son Jesus Christ to save us from our sin and bring us back into a relationship with Himself.
- <u>1 Peter 3:18</u> "For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:"

Acts 17:30-31 "...God...now commandeth all men every where to repent: Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead."

Romans 1:3-4 "...Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh; And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead:"

- "...THAT WHOSOEVER BELIEVETH IN HIM SHOULD NOT PERISH, BUT HAVE EVERLASTING LIFE ."
- **4.** If we believe in Jesus, we can enjoy "everlasting life"—a neverending relationship with God as our Father.

John 3:14-15, 36 "And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: That whosoever

believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life....He that

believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him." Rom. 5:1, Gal. 2:16 "Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ....Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might

be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law:

for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified."

Romans 6:23 "...but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

1 John 5:11-12 "And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life."

John 1:12 "But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:"
